SLIM CD, Inc Updates the Developer's Toolkit

SLIM CD, Inc Announces Enhancements to its Developer's Tool Kit

Coral Springs, FL April 13th, 2010 – SLIM CD, Inc a software developer and service provider announces it has implemented new features for its developer's tool kit: 1) Tokenization enhancements- helps developers avoid the storage of credit card data; 2) Authorizations enhancements- zero-amount authorizations, auth reversals, over-credit a transaction; 3) Open loop gift card- a balance return and partial approval; 4) E-mail/SMS delivery- of electronic receipts delivered via e-mail and/or SMS text.

"Slim CD takes compliance of new card regulations very seriously," said Sami Slim, President and CEO of SLIM CD, Inc. "New compliance rules for authorizations not settled or reversed can result in additional fees." He continued, "Any balance that remains on a gift card will can now be printed on the receipts. Slim CD will uphold all card registration standards and practices."

Tokenization enhancements provide zero-amount authorizations that provide developers with the ability to validate a card number, expiration date, card verification value, and billing address without charging the card. Developers can also load existing databases of cards into SLIM CD's servers using the zero-amount authorizations. Authorization enhancement include auth-reversal that release the funds immediately. Over-credit feature allows larger amounts to be refunded than the original authorization, which allows a single item to be used for multiple charges and a refund can still be performed. Open loop gift card enhancements consist of partial approval which can be added to split-tender across multiple forms of payment, which allows an AUTH or SALE to be approved for less than the amount requested. Balance can be returned for any remaining amount on the gift card after the transaction.

Frank Haggar, Director of Product Development for SLIM CD, Inc, said, "SLIM CD has always supported tokenization as a way of helping developers avoid the storage of credit card data. This feature is implemented by returning a unique id for each transaction submitted to SLIM CD. This id can be stored by the developer and re-transmitted to SLIM CD to perform new transactions." He continued, "We have updated our delivery method to include greater flexibility for receipts including SMS texting and electronic e-mail receipts."

Slim CD will continue to enhance its developer's toolkit and some processor-dependent feature will be rolled out throughout 2010 and 2011.

The SLIM CD includes a desktop application, data on demand, built-in gateway services, fraud detection services, a choice of shopping carts and backup dial-in connection capability. The SLIM CD runs on any personal computer with internet connectivity. Low-cost card swipes, PIN pads, receipt printers and signature capture devices are supported.
